### **What should I bring?**

- Layered clothing as it can get chilly at night.
- Sun block
- Rain wear , while we've had excellent weather every year at the festival, this is a small island and you never know.
- Cash - all vendors prefer cash and you're not going to want to be the only one without a *Maverick Festival 2011* t-shirt.
- Blanket for lounging on the grass.
- Your ticket if you've purchased in advance.
- Your loved ones.

Thieves have been known to frequent festivals, not ours particularly, but be careful where you leave your valuables such as ipods, iphones, ipads, iballs etc. Better still leave them at home!

### **Can I bring my own food?**

- No. There's very reasonably priced, tasty food and drink available at the festival.

### **Can I bring my own alcohol?**

- Camping? Yes, but it must stay in camping area and is not permitted in the festival grounds. Please dispose of your empties thoughtfully as this is a working farm
- Not camping? No, only water as we stock a reasonably priced range of beer, wine, lager & cider and depend on this income to sustain the festival.

### **Are there vegetarian options?**

- Yes. There is a good selection of vegetarian food. Plus, the not-to-be-missed, Suffolk Cider is vegetarian.

### **Can I bring a grill/BBQ?**

- Yes, if it is self-contained.

### **Can I bring my dog?**

- Yes, as long as he/she is kept on a lead whilst in the festival grounds.

### **Can I light a campfire?**

- No fires, the camping field is a meadow and scorched grass is sad and hard for the animals to graze on.

### **Can I bring a camping stove?**

- Yes, but please use responsibly

### **Can I bring fireworks or sparklers?**

- No, unless you want to be trampled by freaked out livestock.

### **Can I use a credit or debit card inside the festival?**

- All vendors prefer cash. Hey, think of the quality time you'll spend listening to great music instead of queuing in the ATM line. (Actually, we don't have an ATM!)

### **How much cash should I bring?**

- That depends on how much beer you intend on drinking.  
- The artists who perform will be signing and selling cds after their shows so save enough to support them and take home a meaningful souvenir.  
- There will be a variety of quality merchandise on sale including Native American Indian jewelry, hemp goods and musical equipment.

### **What sort of safety is there for camping?**

- There are security men with dogs who patrol the campground at night. But it's best to not leave any valuables unattended in your tent and leave non-essentials at home.

### **Is it child-friendly?**
